

## **Archery Range Rules (approved 7/14/15)**

1. Archery range is open daily for general use by Oatka Fish and Game Club members from sunrise to sunset. The range is closed at 7 PM on meeting nights (the third Thursday of the month).
2. Before shooting, all members must sign in at the main clubhouse and obtain a safety flag. The flag is to be displayed at all times at the range while being used. The flag is to be returned to the clubhouse when shooting is complete.
3. Names of the shooters are to be entered in the book at the range. Range books are located in the mailbox at the range.
4. Each non-member must be signed in and accompanied by a member in good standing. Ranges are closed to non-members from October 1st through December 31st. Exception to this rule would be for league shoots and immediate family members (including grandchildren).
5. All bows must be un-nocked when anyone goes down range. All crossbows are to be discharged before anyone goes down range.
6. Crossbows are to be used only with the designated crossbow targets.
7. **No alcoholic beverages or mind-altering drugs are allowed on the ranges. No one having consumed such shall be allowed to shoot at the ranges.**
8. No firearms of any kind are permitted on the archery range at any time.
9. No explosive tips are allowed.
10. Violators of the range rules will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the Oatka Fish and Game Club.
