Archery Range Rules (approved 7/14/15)

- 1. Archery range is open daily for general use by Oatka Fish and Game Club members from sunrise to sunset. The range is closed at 7 PM on meeting nights (the third Thursday of the month).
- 2. Before shooting, all members must sign in at the main clubhouse and obtain a safety flag. The flag is to be displayed at all times at the range while being used. The flag is to be returned to the clubhouse when shooting is complete.
- 3. Names of the shooters are to be entered in the book at the range. Range books are located in the mailbox at the range.
- 4. Each non-member must be signed in and accompanied by a member in good standing. Ranges are closed to non-members from October 1st through December 31st. Exception to this rule would be for league shoots and immediate family members (including grandchildren).
- 5. All bows must be un-nocked when anyone goes down range. All crossbows are to be discharged before anyone goes down range.
- 6. Crossbows are to be used only with the designated crossbow targets.
- 7. No alcoholic beverages or mind-altering drugs are allowed on the ranges. No one having consumed such shall be allowed to shoot at the ranges.
- 8. No firearms of any kind are permitted on the archery range at any time.
- 9. No explosive tips are allowed.
- 10. Violators of the range rules will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the Oatka Fish and Game Club.
