

Rifle/Pistol Range Rules (Approved May 21, 2015) (Amended July 14, 2015)

1. Gun ranges are open daily for general use to members of Oatka Fish and Game Club from 9:00 AM until sunset (7 PM on 3rd Thursday).
2. As per state law, minimum age to shoot is 12 years old.
3. Before shooting, all members must sign in at the Main Clubhouse and obtain a safety flag. The flag is to be displayed at all times at the range while being used. The flag is to be returned to the Clubhouse when shooting is complete. Names of shooters are to be entered in book at the range. Range books are located in the mail box at the range.
4. Each non-member must be signed in and accompanied by a member in good standing. Ranges are closed to non-members from October 1 through December 31. Exception to this rule would be for league shoots and immediate family (including grandchildren).
5. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the ranges. No one having consumed alcoholic beverages shall be allowed to shoot at the ranges.
6. Eye and ear protection are mandatory at the gun ranges.
7. All firearms must be pointed down-range at all times or placed in a gun rack with the action open.
8. All guns must be unloaded and benched when any one goes down-range. No handling of guns is allowed when someone is down-range.
9. Shotguns with slugs may be used at the rifle range. No buckshot to be used at the rifle/pistol range.
10. Shotguns with shot shells must be used / patterned at the trap range.
11. Paper targets are preferred. No reactive targets are to be used. Any metal targets must be placed no closer than 25 yards from the firing line.
12. No rapid fire is permitted.
13. Shooters are to remove used targets and spent casings and dispose of them in the provided containers. Members may collect brass for their own reloading.
14. Violators of the range rules could be subject to disciplinary actions up to and including expulsion from the Oatka Fish and Game Club.
