

Trap Range Rules (Approved May 21, 2015) (Amended July 14, 2015)

1. Trap ranges are open daily for general use to members of Oatka Fish and Game Club from 9 AM until sunset (7 PM on 3rd Thursday). League shoots may start at 8 AM. Ranges are closed when field is being mowed.
2. Non-members must be signed in and accompanied by a member in good standing. Ranges are closed to non-members from October 1 through December 31. Exception to this rule would be for league shoots and family members.
3. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the ranges. No one having consumed alcoholic beverages shall be allowed to shoot at the ranges.
4. Eye and ear protection are mandatory.
5. Before shooting, all members must sign in at the Main Clubhouse and obtain a safety flag. The flag is to be displayed at all times at the range being used. The flag is to be returned to the Clubhouse when shooting is complete. Names of shooters are to be recorded on squad sheets found in range mailbox.
6. All firearms must be pointed down-range at all times or placed in a gun rack with the action open. All guns must be unloaded and pointed in a safe direction when someone is down range.
7. Inexperienced shooters must be accompanied / supervised by an experienced shooter. Minimum age for shooters is 12 years old as per state law.
8. Shotguns with shot shells must be used / patterned at the trap range.
9. No steel shot is to be used at the trap range houses. Steel shot may be used with the hand-set trap or other locations at the trap field.
10. Shooters are to pick up used shot shells and dispose of them in the provided containers.
12. Violators of the range rules could be subject to disciplinary actions up to and including expulsion from the Oatka Fish and Game Club.
